## **Proof of Address and Identity**

- please provide the following documents at reception desk after filling the forms in order so that we can register you.
  - -Photo identification such as a passport, driving licence
  - Proof of address such as a utility bill, bank or mortgage statement, rental
- Please allow at least <u>10 working days</u> to process your application

Patients who have recently arrived from abroad may need to provide evidence that they are entitled to receive treatment from Hospital Services. They may be asked to pay for Hospital treatment if there is no entitlement to free NHS treatment.

Patients not living permanently in the area may still be eligible for the services of a GP and can be seen as a Temporary Resident or an Immediately Necessary Patient.
